

Holy Name of Jesus Church will be re opening for Masses beginning Wednesday, June 24th. There will be 3 English Masses every week; Wednesday at 9am, Saturday at 5 pm and Sunday at 9:30 am.

SEATING IS BY RESERVATION ONLY!

Please remember that the dispensation given by Archbishop Mulhall is still in effect and you are not obligated to attend at this time.

If you are feeling unwell, if you are immunocompromised, or if attending would cause you anxiety please do not attend. Also note that the washrooms will be closed and there will be no access to the Sacristy.

In order to follow the government regulations of less than 30% capacity while still social distancing we will need to implement a sign up list for each Mass. Please call the office or respond to this email with your name and telephone number (and number attending) to let us know which Mass you would like to attend. People who show up at the church without a confirmation on which Mass you are able to attend may be turned away.

The church will open the door 15 minutes before Mass so no need to show up before that.

If you are not working it would help if you could attend the Wednesday Mass to leave room at the weekend Masses for those who can only attend at those times.

Masses will be short. To minimize risk. They will last 20 to 30 minutes.

When you get to the church you will line up outside 6 feet apart (if the weather does not cooperate you may have to wait in your car.) Also please try to limit personal items such as bags and missaltes.

Do not enter the church until an usher greets you. The usher will take you to your seat and will seat from front to back. Once you are in your seat you must remain there for the entire Mass.

Communion will take place at the end of Mass on the way out of the church. Remain in your seat until an usher directs you to leave.

As you approach Fr. Wes you will stop 6 feet from him and he will say "Body of Christ". You will respond "Amen" and then, when you are finished speaking you will approach Fr. Wes where you will receive Holy Communion in the hand. (there will be no communion on the tongue at this time).

You may then drop your donation in the collection basket on your way out.

Please remember to social distance in the church as well as the parking lot and wearing a mask is highly recommended.

No Altar servers are required at this time!
